Voyage description

We expect you on board of the 'Oosterschelde' on Sunday 1 August around 20:00 hours. The ship will be anchored in Oban. The captain warmly welcomes all the guests onboard and as soon as everyone is onboard, he will explain all the (safety) rules and talk you through the plans for the voyage. When the weather is favourable we will try to head north as much as possible during the first part of the voyage. We try to find our way between the rugged Scottish coast and the many islands. We will approximately be out at sea for three days and nights. Once we are past the spectacular current at Pentland Firth we arrive in waters that are more sheltered from bad weather and we are able to plan the rest of the voyage. When we are on schedule we will approach a harbour, for instance Scrabster or Wick. We keep sailing south along the east coast, where we will find remarkable islands along the way, such as Bass Rock, a small island where thousands of Atlantic puffins, Guillemots and Northern gannets build their nests, and Holy Island. The transition from the quiet Scottish coast to the harbour of Hartlepool is great. Many Tall Ships gather here for the North Sea Tall Ships Regatta, in which the 'Oosterschelde' will also participate. Before it is time to say goodbye, you will have the opportunity to meet these ships and their crews and participate in all the activities organised in Hartlepool.
